

## **A Man Shot by a Police Officer.**

Police Officer Paul Heaney attempted to arrest John Farmer, in Ravenswood, Long Island City, about 6 o'clock yesterday afternoon, and the latter, breaking away, ran. Heaney discharged six pistol-shots after the retreating man, the last taking effect in the back and passing into the left lung. The wounded man was taken to the Astoria Station-house, and thence to his home in Hunter's Point, where he now lies in a critical condition. Heaney is under arrest at the Police Headquarters, where he will await the result of the affair.
